

CLEANSING OF THE LEPERS: Luke 5:12-14
Luke 17:11-19

1. In a certain village...we know not where.
2. His miracle of healing in the nameless village has for us heart-searching thoughts. Let us look at them!

1. A PITIFUL SIGHT

1. Ten men that were lepers.
 2. Ten men bound together by a common misery. Such bonds did not lessen the sufferings and dangers of each.
 3. Ten men that could do nothing for themselves.
 4. In Scripture leprosy is the outstanding type of sin.
 5. A look at leprosy as a type of sin
 1. Like sin it brings uncleanness
 2. Like sin, it leads to separation.
 3. Like sin, leprosy is humbly incurable.
2. Earnest prayer. "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us." V. 13

3. A SIMPLE REMEDY. "Go shew yourselves (V.14) unto the priests.

1. This was the law. Lev. 13, 14
2. Do you believe that law? Here two things are necessary:
 1. Faith in the word of Christ. V.
 2. Obedience to the word of Christ
3. They might have said, "We will wait until we feel better." They never would have gone.
