NEGLECT: Latin: Neg-not; legere-to pick up. Not
to pick up...Let alone.

NEGLIGENCE:

1. Causes more than a 100,000 to lose their
lives every year in the United States.
2. The farmer who neglects seed sowing time
will look in vain for a crop at harvest.

PROVERBS 24:30,31; Solomon says, "...I went by
the field of the slothful, and
by the vineyard of the man void of understanding;
And lo, it was all grown over with thorns, and
nettles had covered the face thereof, and the
stone wall thereof was broken down."

1. Those regular in attendance
2. Those irregular in attendance.
3. Those who do not attend at all.

may have their names on church rolls.
2. Their names are not written in heaven.
