We give chapter and verse for what we do:

1. We sing. Eph. 5:19. Col. 3:16; Matt. 26:30; Mark 14:26; James 5:13; Heb. 2:11, 12

2. We pray. Acts 2:42; Acts 12:5, 12; .

3. We teach and admonish one another. Even as we sing, Col. 3:16. Acts 2:42; 1 Tim. 1:3; 2 Tim. 2:2; 2:24; Heb. 5:11-14.

4. We observe the Lord's supper. Matthew 26:26-29. Acts 2:42; The frequency with which they observed the Lord's supper is not here stated but later on we find; ~~MMMM~~ Acts 29:7, they came together on the first day of the week to break bread.

5. We give of our means. 1 Cor. 16:1,2. There are many New Testament examples.

1. Let every one of you... Not confined to a certain group but the common duty of all.

2. Lay by him in store... Not under some pathetic appeal or for display.

3. As God has prospered him... To set forward on one's way... prosper one's journey.
