4. We are supported by Christ. The Captain of our salvation. Heb. 2:10 2. Why some will not endure hardness.

1. Over-come by ease and self-indulgence. 2. They lack energy and courage.

3. Preasure seeking, outward prosperity, and honor

have over come them. 3. THE Duty of the good Soldier.

I. He must resolutely shake off the entanglements of the affairs of this life ... that he may please . 2. He must make every effort to the defence of the

gospel of Christ. 1. He must preach the gospel.

2. He must uphold it against all gainsayers. 3. He must adorn the gospel of Christ with his

1. The example of Christ's suffering ... his resurrection.

1. Remember Christ risen from the dead...he seemed to be utterly defeated in death.

2. The example of Paul. 1. Wherein I suffer trouble as an evil doer. Verse 9

2.2I suffer it for the elects sake. Verse 100 5. THIS IS A FAITHFUL SAYING. VERSES 11-14
1. A faithful saying for consolation and for warning.

1. If we be dead with him: Verse 11 2. If we deny him. Verse 12
