  - 3. these facts constitute the gospel and this was the first time the gospel was preached in fact. MANNAMM 1 Corinthians 15:1-4
- 2. Pentecest was the beginning of the rule of the Spirit.

  1. He came on Pentecest to abide with us forever.

  Jehn 14:16
  - 2. He was the Author of the word. 2 Tim. 3:16
  - He abides with us today in the Word. John 6:63
     What the Word does the Spirit does and waht the Spirit does the Word does.
- 3. Pentecest was the beginning of the Christian age.

  - 4. In speaking with the apostles he had promised,
    "For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall
    be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days
    hence." Acts 1:5
  - 5. They were to tarry in Jerusalem until this power of came upon them. Luke 24:49; Acts 1:4
