

THE BIBLE

1. Consists of sixty-six books.
2. Thirty-nine books in the Old Testament.
3. Twenty-seven books in the New Testament.
4. Testament means covenant or will:
 - a. The Old Will; b. The New Will. ^{Heb} 9:15, 16
5. The Old Testament abolished: Col. 2:14.

New Testament Law Superior to O^{ld}.

1. O^{ld} Law a covenant of bondage: Gal. 5:1.⁴
2. Old Law Characterized by imperfections.
Hebrews 8:7; 7:11, 12.⁴
3. No remission of sins under Old Law. Heb. 10:¹

New Testament Law has no imperfections.

1. It is a law of liberty. Gal. 5:1.
2. It is a perfect law of liberty. James 1:25
3. One enters the holy place, the church, by the blood of Jesus. Heb. 10-22.

MAIN DIVISIONS OF THE NEW TESTAMENT. The New Testament is logically divided into four main divisions; namely,

1. Gospel Records: Matthew, Mark, Luke, John.
 - a. Inspired commentaries on the life of Christ. Written that people believe.
2. Acts of the Apostles: a. Inspired history of the church during first operation.
3. Epistles and Letters. Romans-Jude. (21)
 - a. Problems that arose. Christians how to behave in the house of God.
4. Revelation. Admonitions of Christian living
