INTRODUCTION: What is the fundamental truth of the gospel?

1. It is: Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God.

QUESTIONS TONIGHT: What is the fundamental fact of the gospel?

1. It is: That God raised up his Son Jesus from the dead.
 1. Rom. 1:4; "And declared to be the Son of God with power.. by the resurrection from the dead"
 2. Acts 2:24; "Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it."

QUESTION TWO: What is the fundamental requirement of the gospel?

1. It is: The requirement of the gospel is obedience to Christ.
 1. "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him."
Matt. 17:5
 2. John 14:15, "If ye love me, keep my commandments."
 3. Phil, 2:8; Jesus learned obedience
 4. Heb. 5:9; Jesus the author of salvation to all who obey.
Matt. 7:24-27 also.
