

USE OF THE WORD "WORLD" IN THE NEW TESTAMENT.

1. 1 Peter 3:3 it seems to mean ornament.
2. Romans 1:20 it means the ordered universe.
3. John 1:9 it means the earth itself.
4. John 3:16 it means the inhabitants of the earth.
5. 1 John 2:15, our text, and also Romans 12:2, means "the things of the world," all that is alienated from God.
6. "FOR ALL THIAIT IS IN THE WORLD." 1 John 2:16
  1. The lust of the flesh: All lust that has its seat  
( in the flesh. Gal.5:16  
Eph. 2:2  
(1) See works of the flesh (Gal.5:17-21)  
(2) Gen. 3:6; "And the woman saw that the tree was good for food." LUST OF THE FLESH
  2. The lust of the eyes: All lust that has its origin in sight.  
(1) Gen. 3:6; And the woman saw that it was pleasant (a delight) to the eyes.
  3. The pride (vain glory) of life: Ostentation living exhibited in the manner of living.  
(1) The empty pride and pretentiousness of fashion and diplay.  
(2) A desire to our shine and obtain credit which does not belong to us.
7. WE ARE FACED WITH TWO POWERS IN THE WORLD.
  1. Satan and his power: The sum of all evil which make for sin.
  2. God and his will: The good power that makes for righteousness.
8. ONLY THREE SOURCES OF TEMPTATION: All temptation must come through one.
  1. The lust of the flesh. 2. The lust of the eyes.
  3. The lust of the pride of life.
