

1. Tithe: To tax the amount of a tenth; especially for support of church

2. Lighter matters about which they were careful:

(1) For ye pay tithes of: mint

a. Mint: The bitter herb of Exodus 12:8. Often hung up in the synagogue for its fragrance

b. Anise: Known to us as dill. Used much in medicine, seasoning

c. Cummin: A small plant of Egypt & Syria with seeds like caraways. Used as condiment and also medicine.

3. The Weightier Matters. 6:8

(1) Judgment, Justice to others. Micah
There should be right attitude toward:

a. Magistrates - Rom. 13:1; 1 Pet. 2:13, 14

b. Neighbors - Rom. 13:10; Luke 10:29

c. Citizens - Luke 15:15; 19:14

(2) Mercy: Forbearance toward the guilty. Compassion and Kindness toward the poor & Miserable
Matt. 5:7; Luke 6:38; 18:13; 18:22; 19:8.

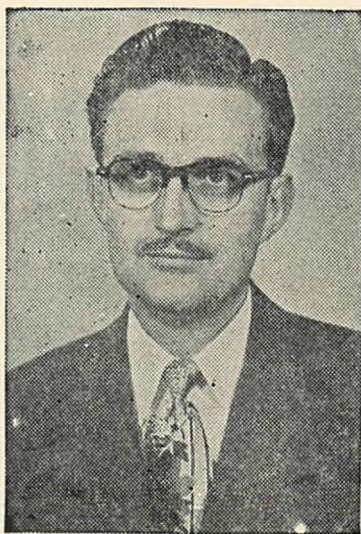
(3) Faith: Is both the belief of the truth and habitual manifestation of the truth in life
