## TEACH-TEACHING

1. Definition: To make to know how...to show how.  
To impart knowledge of.

## JESUS THE MASTER TEACHER

1. Jesus began to teach them many things. Mark 6:34
2. The people acknowledge Jesus as a teacher of truth concerning the way of God. Luke 20:21, 22
3. Jesus' teaching in his sermon on the mount. ~~Matthew 7:28, 29~~

## PAUL AS

PAUL A GREAT TEACHER Acts 20:20, 27, 31 *Did not shrink under*

1. Paul's teaching: *the influence of fear, imbalance.*
  - (1) I kept back nothing that was profitable for you.
  - (2) I have not shunned to declare unto you all the counsel of God. Verse 27, Acts 20
  - (3) I ceased not to warn everyone (for three years) night and day with tears. Acts 20:31
2. Where Paul taught:
  - (1) I taught you publicly. Acts 20:20
  - (2) I taught you from house to house. Acts 20:20

## OUR DUTY TO TEACH Matthew 28:19, 20

1. Go ye therefore:
  - (1) Teach all nations...baptize them.
  - (2) Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you. Matt. 28:20

## REQUIREMENTS OF A TEACHER

1. Desire...we have to want to.
2. WE NEED RIGHT TOOLS:
  - (1) We need a good Bible.
  - (2) We need a good Bible Dictionary
  - (3) We need a good English Dictionary.
  - (4) We need a good Commentary on the Bible.

## HINDERANCES

1. Lack of desire...no effort...no preparation.
2. Wrong tools: Too many books and literature about Bible
3. Wrong kind of living. Worldly, not willing to give up worldliness to qualify for a Bible teacher.
