- 3-The beauties of nature and the beauties of art, as leading man to forget God.
- 2-It reveals man as to weak to behold the means of easily obtaining life's comforts.
  - 1-The gold, silver and garments was to attractive to Achin.

2-UNBELIEF: A mere withholding of belief.

3-With all the works of God before his eyes: 1-The battle of Jericho.

2-The crossing of Jordan.

3-No doubt could remember some things that came to pass in the wilderness wandering Achan could not deliberately disbelieve that God saw and that God would punish.

4-As a coin before the eye, the gold and the garment did but shut out the future.

1-Present pleasure and present possession, just then, mad up the whole vision of the man's life.
