

BY GRACE ARE YE SAVED. Ephesians 2:8,9.

Note:

These verses call attention to four things which we would like to consider. They are:

- 1- Salvation is by grace through faith.
2. Salvation is not of one's self.
3. Salvation is the gift of God.
4. Salvation is not of works.

The Bible emphasizes certain conditions that must be met before one can be saved. There is such a thing as conditional giving. We consider:

1. The brazen serpent. Numbers 21:4-9. vs 21:4-9

(a) God's gift...life. God's conditions upon which one might have life... "Who so looketh upon it."

This is giving when conditions have been met.

2. The city of Jericho. Joshua 2:9, 24; 6:2.

(a) Rahab and the two spies and the Lord:

1. I know the Lord hath given you the land.
2. The Lord hath delivered into our hands all the land.
3. I have given into thine hand Jericho.

3. Naaman the Leper. 2 Kings 5:1-14.

(a) God had a great blessing to bestow on Naaman. God determined to bestow that blessing when certain conditions were met. They were: Dipping in Jordan seven times. Conditions met...Blessing received.
