1-Comes to the English vocabulary by way of Latin.

2-Suited to ones personal ease or comfort.

3-Suited to ones easy performance of of some act or function.

3-An act or function that may be performed by one without inconvenience. Nothing else to do

2-After Felix heard Paul's sermon, he said:
