 1. The way of man is not in himself. Jeremiah 10:23.
Titus 3:5
 2. Without divine guidance we would not know how to live the Christian life. See 2 Peter 1:5-11
2. The passages teach us that God offers his guidance to us.
 1. That he knows our true conditions and even knows our false estimation of some things. Rev. 2:9
 2. That we are to ask God for guidance in all things. James 1:5,8
3. The passages teach that God has ways of guiding us.
 1. He guides us through his word. Psalms 119:105
 2. The Ephesian elders learned from watching Paul. At least they should have. Acts 20:35
 3. He guides us through the good and faithful lives of other Christians. 2 Cor. 3:2
 4. There is no doubt but that some are guided, at least warned, by some events that come to pass in their lives.
 1. A disaster of some kind.
 2. A sudden death in the family.
 3. A failure of the physical man. (The blind man in New York city who obeyed the gospel after blindness came upon him) ETC.
