1. Positive Divine Law. We have:

- (a) Positive divine institutions.
- (b) Positive appointments.
- (c) Positive commandments. On the other hand we have what is known as moral law:

(2) Moral Law.

2. Moral Law

- (a) Moral law relates to that which is right in itself. Always was right and requires things to be done because they are right.

- ( 1. It has always been right to speak the truth, and wrong to speak a lie. Moral law requires the former because it is right, and forbids the latter because it is wrong.

3. Positive divine law is of a higher order than moral law. It has the force to make right that which is not right intrinsically in itself and is the highest test of respect for divine authority known to man. There are three degrees in this before it can reach the highest test:

- (1) To obey when we cannot see that the thing commanded can do any good in itself.

- (2) To obey when we can see quite clearly that the thing commanded cannot do any good in itself.

- (3) To obey when we can see that the thing commanded is wrong in itself, morally speaking.
