 - 1-Commuting takes time and distances are long---Especially to church.
 - 2-This has so completely upset the family's schedule:
 - 1-That they are seldom all together for breakfast.
 - 2-They are never together for lunch.
 - 3-Often they are not even together for dinner.

- 5-What has the Barr family been doing? 1-They have been to self-indulgent.
 - 2-They have been too much influenced by the lax social ideals of pagan neighbors.
 - 3-They have been dallying with the flase gods of pleasure:

1-Fashion. - Popularity. - Social Prestige.
Bridge. - Country-club goff, and business
success.

6-What the Barr family Needs:

1-They need to put "First things first."
Matthew 6:33;

But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

7-The great need of America -- Accredited Christian Homes.

1-The home must be a school of Christian living---This is the high purpose of the home.

8-To be an accredited Christian home there must be a willingness:

1-To maintain family worship in some form regularly-daily.

1-Reading of the Bible.

2-Prayer with the children at night or in the morning of the day.

3-Prayer at the table for each meal.
