V 1- In 9:1, Paul expresses great sorrow & unceasing pain of his heart for his countrymen, would be anathema if they could be save

Here repeats his love, tells what heart's desire is: Might be saved, not in unbelief tho Some seem to think preachers enjoy proclaiming fact that disobedient will be lost, but true man of God is always desirous of sale

vation of listeners. Has no business preaching if he does not love souls.

HEART'S DESIRE & PRAYER - Some prayers cold & formal, from teeth outward.

Possible to have desire without prayer & prayer without heart's desire.

V 2- Zeal of God - Had not gone into idola-

rentecost)
Passionate ardor in things pertaining to God & religion. Were sincere, but that not sufficient - See John 16:2. Acts 26:9.

Lev: - Caul to apastles - Caul thore he was pastles - Caul thor

Many suppose that if they are zealous & sincere God must be pleased.

Paul willing to give credit where credit due, but zeal was
NOT ACC. TO KNOWLEDGE - Was inexcusable, due to their stubborn refusal to see or hear.
See Matt 13:15.

Note: Enowledge without zeal becomes cold, formal, and may be possessed by devils or infidels. Union of two is real religion.

V 3- Ignorance of Jews was voluntary.

People in land of Bibles have voluntary ignorance. See John 5:39,40. Luke 13:34.

Difference in them & Paul in i Tim. 1:13.

If he had persecuted Christians, Knowing them to be right, it would have been different.

Willingness to hear & change makes the difference.

OF GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS- of God's plan for making men righteous.

ESTABLISH THEIR CWN- righteousness of their own works, law and traditions of men.
Mark 7:7,8.

HAVE NOT SUBMITTED THEMSELVES- Confident in their own plan. No obstacle to salvation of great as self-righteousness of sinner.

"Ital be baptized if I thought I was lost."

y 4- END OF LAW- Purpose of lew is to bring people to Christ. "A tutor to bring us unto Christ." Those who claim to follow law but reject Christ are ignorant of aim & teaching of law.

the If Jews had used law right, it would have imparted to them knowledge of sinfulness, & make them desire a Savior, and insured His reception by Jews.

V 5- "Moses Writeth" - Lev. 18:5 To secure justification, obedience to law must be perfect. Gal. 3:10 James 2:10

V 6- Was originally a quotation of Moses, near the end of his life, Deut. 30:11-14. Moses commands were plain, intelligible,

easy to understand. Did not require long journeys, deep research, or painful toil. If that true of doctrines of Moses, how much

more true of Christ's law.

Faith does not demand a visible demonstration of Christ's coming down from heaven or up from the grave. Seen by chosen witnesses who bore testimony. Hard hearted Jews made demands that Christ be brought down from heaven before they would believe, or brought up from the dead. Lanarus Faith does not set forth the conditions on

which they will believe.

V &- WORD NIGHT THEE - easy to understand. easily obtained ...

Facts of gospel so well known thro apostl preaching, said to be in every man's mouth should be subject of meditation of heart.

V-9- CONFESS, BELIEVE * This order is used to show that confession, (external) shid correspond with internal feelings (belief in heart). One needs courage to declare faith to world. Matt. 10:32,33 John 12:42.

V 10- Shows that belief must precede confession. Must begin in heart.

Not just a formal confession, but daily in lives. Our lives are DAILY PROFESSION.

Belief and confession both UNTO righteousnes and salvation.

V

V 11- "Whosever" believeth - Does it mean living, working active faith, or belief without completing itself? Previous verse "believing UNTO" shows it means belief that leads to obedience.

V 12- JEW AND GREEK- (all Gentiles) Under Greeks for centureies, later cultured Romans spoke Greek language. RICH MUNTO ALL- No multitude can exhaust

V 13- CALL ON NAME OF LORD not faith only, formal belief, formal calling. (Matt. 7:21)

V 14- Belief comes before, and is separate

act from calling on name of Lord.

IN. WHOM THEY HAVE NOT HEARD— heard or read, recd God's word in some way. (John 20:31)
"These things written that ye might believe"

V 15- Preachers sent - Shows necessity of him who went forth to preach being sent of God, having credentials from God) Has reference to original sending of gospel preachers, apostles.

Before leaving earth Christ told apostles

Before leaving earth, Christ told apostles he would send Spirit to guide them into all truth. After his death & res., by which he was declared to be son of God, he gave great commission, then ascended to heaven.

On day of Pentecost, while apostles tarried

in Jerusalem, they were filled with Holy Spirit, and spoke as spirit gave them utterance. Made known the conditions of remission of sins & entrance into church of God.

Later Lord appeared unto Paul "to make him a minister & a witness" Acts 26:16.

Read Gal. 1:12.

So no one preaches, or is sent, now in the sense that those men went forth to proclaim —gospel. Today's men are only teachers of that which had been preached by these men sent of God, endowed with Holy Spirit.

To use this verse to mean that God today uses some supernatural force to "SEND" preachers today, destroys the force of the truth that in that day the apostles were supernaturally endowed & SENT. 2 Jun 2:2

out these original teachers were sent of God Quotes Isaiah- 52:7 Message so precious, joy so great to those who recd it, that

In some sende today, churches send preachers

joy so great to those who reed it, that very feet of those who brought it declared to be beautiful.

V 16- In Paul's day, as in time of Isaiah, all who heard did not rec. message.

V 17- HOW DOES FAITH COME? by some miraculous way, something better felt than told? BY HEARING THE WORD OF CHRIST. The SEED is word of God, develops & grows, then bears fruit.

We see need of preaching (teaching). If God by direct operation of spirit wrought faith in heart, he could dispense with preacher.

V 13- DID THEY NOT HEAR? Iffaith comes by hearing, the responsibility to some extent restedon those who have the word to proclaim:

DID THEY FILENIA THEIR OBLIGATION? Yes.

DID THEY FULFULL THEIR OBLIGATION? Yes, their sound went out into all the earth, & words to ends of world. HOW? From day of Pentecost, from scattering after persecution.

OUR RESPONSIBILITY TODAY?

V 19- DID ISPARL NOT KNOW? Seems to refer back to Gentiles receiving gospel. Did not Israel know that Gentiles would have gospel preached? If not, it was bec. they had closed eyes & refused to see plain teaching of Jewish scriptures. Deut 32:21

Moses first prophesied such: Fulfilled in Acts 13:44-48.

V 20- Isaiah also- Gospel offered to Gentile who never once thought of inquiring after true God, they broke their idols, burned their books, surrendered to Christ, began to walk in newness of life. Celass. 18,19

V 21- ALL DAY LONG- continually, without intermission STRETCHED FORTH HANDS, entreated. GAINSAYING - speaking against. NO NEW DOCTRINE WITH PAUL, BUT WAS IN JEWISH WRITINGS THEMSELVES. Jan 65:2
