1-Presumptuous means: Adjective

- 1-Overweeningly proud.
- 2-Self-confident, or venturesome.
- 3-Very bold.
- 4-Taking undue liberties.

2-Last Lord's day I pointed out that presumptuous sins are numerous:

1-Profane swearing; False swearing; Evil courses of every kind.

2-In a broad comprehensive statement:

- 1-Presumptuous sins might be identified as the wilful violation of any one or all of God's commands.

3-This morning, we study "presumptuous sins" from the view point of:

1-Taking undue liberties, or doing things without authority.

1-Rev. 22:18-19;

For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of this prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: (19) And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

2-Deut.4:2; God said to Israel, *also 12:32*

Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the Lord which I command you. (lose)

2-Those who ~~take away~~ shall their part out of the book of life and the holy city.

3-Those who add too---- God shall add unto them the plagues that are written in this book.

4#Sinning presumptuously as it respects professors of religion:

-1-When they take up a profession of religion without principle.

1-Principle is:

1-A settled rule of action.

2-A governing law of conduct.

3-A principle as being essential to given body.

2-Standing for everything in general and nothing in particular may be a double cousin to the "unpardonable sin."

3-Religious conviction of this sort:

1-There is no underlying principle or depth of conviction....Religion of this kind is an insult to the throne of God and a serious threat to the well-being of family life and bids fair to overthrow any nation, or nations, wherein it becomes prevalent.

- 2-When they profess to ask the blessings of God, and yet go on in forbidden courses.

1-They profess to know God..

Titus 1:16;

They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.
