1. Points of Resemblance.

- a. Both heard Christ's sayings.
- b. Both saw the necessity of building a house.
- c. Both built a house.
- d. Both, no doubt, felt secure in the house each had built.

2. Points in which they differ.

- a. They differed in character: One wise:
One foolish.
- b. They differed in their practice.
 1. One heard Jesus and obeyed.
Heb. 5:8, 9; 1 Pet. 1:22, 23.
 2. The other heard and did not obey.
2 Thess. 1:7-9; 1 Pet. 4:17,18.
- c. They differed in the foundations on which they built. Nothing can make up for a faulty foundation. Their houses may have looked alike. ROCK....SAND.

3. The Two Results

- a. Elements of weather: rains, floods, wind.
 1. One stood.
 2. The other fell.
