1. Titus not mentioned in Acts.

2. He was a Gentile. Gal. 2:3.

3. He was at Jerusalem with Paul and Barnabas. Titus' presence in Jerusalem gave offence to the Jews but Paul did not have him circumcised. Gal. 2:1-5.

Why was Timothy circumcised? Acts 16:3.

4. Titus was no doubt converted by Paul. 1:4

5. Why he was left in Crete. Titus 1:5.

TIME AND PLACE OF WRITING:

1. Perhaps written from Nicopolis in Macedonia on the west coast of Greece. or Macedonia

2. Written perhaps A. D. 65-68.

TIMOTHY:

2. Well reported of for good works. 1 Tim. 5:10

3. To be rich in good works. 1 Tim. 6:18.

4. Prepared unto every good work. 2 Tim. 2:21

TITUS:

1. Reprobate to every good work. Titus 1:16
All God's commands are good works, and he who prefers other ways to God's way cannot do God's work.

2. A pattern of good works. Titus 2:7

3. Zealous of good works. Titus 2:14.

4. Ready unto every good work. Titus 3:1

5. Careful to maintain good works. Titus 3:8

6. Maintain good works for necessary uses.
