1-The mission of the New Testament Church is to preach the gospel:

1st "Go ye therefore." This commission is given primarily:

1-To the apostles: their duty was to transmit the gospel from nation to nation-to the end of the world in place.

2-This commission is given to the successors of the apostles, the ministers of the gospel, whose business it is to transmit the gospel from age to age, to the end of the world in time.

2-The great commission is the marching order of the church of Christ-"Go Teach."

3-Jesus the Master Teacher:
