1. The mere unintelligent hearer, who hears but receives not.  
*1. Hears but hears nothing*
2. The shallow hearer, whose emotions are superficially touched, but whose heart is still hard.
3. The hearer whose heart is fully right, but is at last conquered by outward temptations.
4. The persevering and fruitful receiver of the word.
  1. Of the four classes only the last one can be saved.
5. A parable is something laid alongside another thing, to measure, compare, or explain it.
6. A parable differs with a fable in that it never represents impossible things or circumstances, such as trees walking, animals talking, or horses flying, and such like.
