INTRODUCTION : Today is the day; not tomorrow. TOMORROW: the greatest robber of men. Opportunity, time, money, most of all men's souls all slip away in the battlements (open spaces) of tomorrow. Tomorrow never comes

## Today is the day of salvation because:

- 1. We know not the time of our departure from this life. Our life is so brief. Read God's word:
  - 1. Job 7:6, 7; "My days are swifter than a weaver's shuttle and are spent without hope." "O remember that my life is wind: mine eye shall no more see good."
  - 2. James 4:13-14; 1 Peter 1:24
- 2. God hath spoken. Heb. 1:1,2
  - I. Not the words of men, Disciplines written by men, Confessions of faith: Westminster Confession of Faith by the presbyterian church.
  - 2. God's word is going to judge us. John 12:48; "He that rejecteth

me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day."

- 3. The Lord stands at the door of the heart of the lost soul knocking today. He may not knock tomorrow. Rev. 3:20-22. 1. Christ standing at our door ... we should be standing at his door, for he is the door. John 10:7, 9.
  - 2. The soul may be likened to a great place with many doors. Christ knocks sometimes at one door and then at another. He may:
    - 1. Knock at the door of intellect: Presents the evidence of the reasonableness of his faith & claims.
    - 2. Knock at the door of conscience, the door of bove, the door of fear, the door of hope.
- 4. Death and the judgement are certain. Heb. 9:27.
  - 1. Death is, and will be a sentence against which no appeal can be heard. It will be hard to part with so many friends, so many interest, so much work, so many hopes: but there is no help for it.
